DAY BY DAY

DAY I	Arrival — the drive and the King's Chauffeured north from Edinburgh or Glasgow, arriving down the beech avenue in time for lunch. An afternoon round on the King's — Braid's heathland masterpiece — then the American Bar before dinner in The Strathearn.	<i>1h 00 transfer · 72 km from Edinburgh</i>
DAY II	The Queen's and the glen Morning on the Queen's, the gentler and prettier of the pair, with caddies arranged. Afternoon at leisure: falconry on the lawn, gundogs in the covert, or the spa. Dinner at Andrew Fairlie, held under our name.	<i>On the estate · no transfer</i>
DAY III	PGA Centenary — the Ryder Cup ground The Jack Nicklaus course that hosted the 2014 Ryder Cup, played from the tees of your choosing. Evening: a private cask tasting in the Blue Bar, or a quiet table by the fire.	<i>On the estate · no transfer</i>
DAY IV	A day out — Perthshire and the Tay Optional links day at Carnoustie or Kingsbarns, or a slower Perthshire circuit — Scone Palace, the Fortingall Yew, and salmon beats on the Tay. Home to Gleneagles for the last night.	<i>45 min transfer · 38 km</i>
DAY V	Departure Breakfast at leisure, a final nine if the tee sheet allows, then chauffeured transfer to Edinburgh, Glasgow or a private terminal.	<i>1h 00 transfer · 72 km to Edinburgh</i>

ROOMS & HOUSE USE

Estate Suite	<i>Corner rooms over the parkland, fairways visible from the window at first light.</i>
Braid House Suite	<i>The quietest wing of the house — sitting room, dressing room, garden outlook.</i>
Whole-wing use	<i>For parties of eight to fourteen, with a dedicated butler and private dining.</i>
The Townhouse, Edinburgh	<i>A city night either side of the estate, on the same account.</i>
