This is the full register — a passage across three coasts, three castles, and the country's finest whisky houses. Reserved for parties who value quiet arrangement over visible movement.

DAY BY DAY

DAY 01 Arrival · The Ayrshire Coast

Prestwick · Turnberry

Met privately at Prestwick, forty minutes south to Turnberry. Late lunch on the terrace facing Ailsa Craig, the lighthouse at the point. A single dram after dinner; no play tonight.

DAY 02 Ailsa at Turnberry

Turnberry · Ayrshire

The Ailsa Course — the country's most photographed links. Postage-stamp ninth to the lighthouse, sea on three sides. Afternoon at leisure, or a helicopter loop over the Isle of Arran.

DAY 03 North to Fife · Muirfield en route

East Lothian · St Andrews

A morning round at Muirfield when the club receives us — the finest inland-feeling links in Britain. Long lunch at Greywalls, then north across the Forth to St Andrews. Arrive Rusacks before dusk.

DAY 04 The Old Course

St Andrews · Fife

First tee at daybreak. Senior local caddie per guest. R&A; tea when arrangements allow. Afternoon in the town — Luvians for wine, Aikman's for a quiet dram.

STAY	Rusacks St Andrews
DINE	18 at Rusacks · rooftop

DAY 05 Kingsbarns · North through the Cairngorms

Fife · Sutherland

A morning round at Kingsbarns. Lunch in the clubhouse, then private car north through the Cairngorms — five hours through Highland country. Arrive Skibo before dinner.

STAY	Skibo Castle · private lodge
DINE	Skibo Great Hall

DAY 06 Royal Dornoch

Sutherland Highlands

The connoisseur's course, in the long north light. The gorse, the tight turf, the sea to the east. A single round, played slowly. Skibo whisky library after dinner — the estate's private cask.

STAY Skibo Castle

DINE Skibo Whisky Library

DAY 07 Castle Stuart · Departure Inverness

Firth of Moray · Inverness

A closing round at Castle Stuart, sweeping views across the Firth. Late lunch at Rocpool. Afternoon transfer to Inverness for a private jet departure, or onward south by helicopter.
