The Kingdom

Four days · Fife & East Lothian · A first passage through the ancient ground.

A four-day passage for the guest arriving with limited days and undiminished expectations. Two rounds at St Andrews, a chosen day on the East Lothian coast, and evenings held in a Georgian townhouse on The Scores. Pace is deliberate — one round a day, long lunches, whisky at the fire, and time to walk the town between rounds. We do not stack tee times; the Kingdom rewards patience.

DAY BY DAY

DAY 01

Arrival · Edinburgh to St Andrews

Edinburgh · Fife

Met privately airside at Edinburgh. A chauffeured Range Rover carries you north across the Forth. Afternoon check-in at Rusacks, seaview suites overlooking the 18th. An early supper in town — no golf on day one, by design.

PLAY	Rest day. Walking tour of the Old Course and the town at dusk.
STAY	Rusacks St Andrews — Seaview Suite
DINE	18 at Rusacks · rooftop, tasting menu

DAY 02

The Old Course

St Andrews · Fife

First tee, morning light. Senior local caddie per guest. Tea in the R&A; when arrangements allow. Afternoon at leisure — the Himalayas putting green or the West Sands. Evening drams at the Kenly Room, an unadvertised whisky library kept for the house.

DAY 03 Kingsbarns & the Coast

Kingsbarns · Fife

A short drive south to Kingsbarns — cliff-top links, modern in build, ancient in feel. Lunch at the clubhouse overlooking the North Sea. Afternoon private tasting at Kingsbarns Distillery, three cask draws led by the distiller.

STAY	Rusacks St Andrews
DINE	Private dinner · Cambo Estate

DAY 04 Muirfield or North Berwick · Departure

East Lothian

South across the Forth. A morning round at Muirfield when the club receives us, or North Berwick's West Links as an equally storied alternative. Long lunch at Greywalls, then a private car onward to Edinburgh, the airport, or a rail carriage south.

STAY	Day-use at Greywalls Hotel
DINE	Chez Roux at Greywalls · lunch

Rusacks St Andrews *Marine Hotel · St Andrews*

Our anchor house in the town. Seaview suites overlook the 18th and the Swilcan Bridge.

The Peat Inn *One Michelin Star · Fife*

A quiet room ten minutes inland. Chef Geoffrey Smeddle's tasting menu paired to a private Burgundy list.

Kingsbarns Distillery *Single Malt · Fife Coast*

Three-cask draws with the distillery manager. Bottles engraved and shipped to your address.

Greywalls Hotel *Country House · Muirfield*

Lutyens-designed, walled gardens by Gertrude Jekyll. Our lunch stop after East Lothian play.
